

## **SIGMOIDOSCOPY**

Yo	u have been booked for a gastroscopy appointment for
	Report to the ENDOSCOPY UNIT ( $6^{th}$ floor) 1 hour prior TO CHECK IN.
	TWO WEEKS PRIOR - CONFIRM your appointment
	You should receive an appointment reminder about 2 weeks prior. If you need to cancel and reschedule, email <a href="mailto:HuangIBDclinic@sinaihealthsystem.ca">HuangIBDclinic@sinaihealthsystem.ca</a> or call 416-586-4800 ext 2475.
	<b>Medications</b> : Notify <b>Dr. V. Huang</b> you are on these meds when booking the endoscopy:
	<ul> <li>Aspirin</li> <li>Blood thinners</li> <li>Insulin or pills for diabetes</li> </ul>
	ONE WEEK PRIOR - PREPARE for sigmoidoscopy
	If you need to cancel your appointment, please call the office <b>at least 7 days in advance</b> Arrange for a responsible adult to take you home after your procedure.
	THE DAY BEFORE
	NOTHING to eat or drink after midnight
	DAY OF THE SIGMOIDOSCOPY PROCEDURE
	On the day of the examination, have nothing to eat or drink for at least 4 hours prior to the sigmoidoscopy. You may take your regular medications with sips of water.
	4 hrs before your appointment time, insert 1 bottle of Fleet enema into rectum, and clean out the stool in the rectum.
	If you are having sedation for the procedure  o ensure you have a responsible adult to pick you up  o if you do not, your procedure may be cancelled or done without sedation.

Photo Identification
Bring all your medications (including insulin) with you or a Medication List
Bring a garment bag with you for your clothing.
Do NOT bring valuables, jewelry, or large sums of money.

## AFTER THE SIGMOIDOSCOPY PROCEDURE

- During the procedure, you may be given a mild sedative by the intravenous route.
  - The total recovery time required in the hospital following the procedure is about 1 to 2 hours.
- Aside from drowsiness, you should feel normal when you leave the hospital.
  - o However, you should not drive or operate any heavy machinery until the following day.
  - You should be able to resume eating light meals later in the day and return to normal activities the next day.
- Should you develop abdominal pain or unusual bleeding from the rectum

- If the symptoms are severe and you cannot get through to the doctor's office
  - o please go to the closest emergency department.
- Biopsies take 10 to 14 days for results.
